The Trainer is responsible for providing a robust training experience for community attendees in-person and/or virtually based on community requests and program needs.

Responsibilities:

- The Trainer will be required to present a minimum of three (3) trainings per month (through Zoom or in-person).
- Our administrative staff will assist with scheduling and marketing the training; we ask that the Trainer comes prepared to set up for the training and is responsible for teaching, documentation, and interfacing directly with attendees as needed throughout the training experience. Experience with public speaking to audiences of various sizes, compositions, and levels of interaction is desired.
- Afternoon to evening (5pm – 8pm) availability is preferred. We ask that our Trainers are knowledgeable or open to learning about specific mental health resources and training topics.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bilingual in Spanish or Vietnamese is preferred.
- Bachelor’s degree in Mental Health, Psychology, Social Work, Social Sciences or related field.
- Working with allied professionals and the ability to interface with industry contacts is highly preferred.
