- Monitors reports and brings inconsistencies to Program Director/Supervisors

- Review/ensure NOABD's are sent out accordingly.
- Monitor workflow.
- Meets with Clinical Supervisor team to ensure communication of program updates/changes occur.

- Monitors implementation of processes

Minimum Qualifications:

- Master's degree in social work (MSW) and registration as an Associate Social Worker with the Board of Behavioral Sciences; or a master's degree in Marriage and Family Therapy and registration as Marriage and Family Therapy Intern with the Board of Behavioral Science or required licensure.
- Current California Licensure in Marriage Family Child Counseling, Social Work or Psychology required.
- Two (2) years' experience post licensure.
- Experience with supervision, experience with EBPs, and certification in EBPs preferred.
- Knowledge of Medi-Cal/Cal Aim Billing and documentation, ability to utilize reports in EHR.
